The project involves the construction of two NHL sized ice surfaces complete with 12 dressing rooms, spectator seating and other necessary service areas along with the construction of a 2000 person community room which is divisible into smaller rooms, complete with a large entrance lobby, washrooms, bars, a warming kitchen as well as other necessary service rooms.

The site work requires the extension of McCarthy Road and complete site services to provide paved parking for 778 cars and turf stone parking for 174 additional cars as well as landscaping, a storm water management pond and site lighting.
